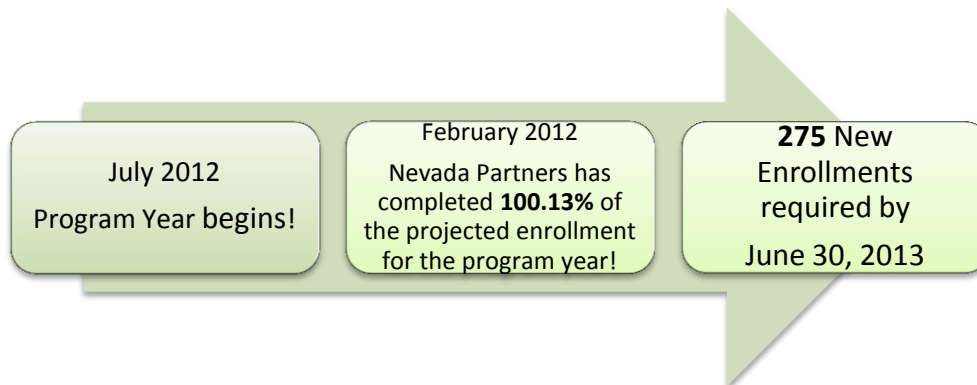




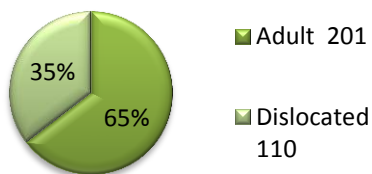
WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Nevada Partners is making strides! To date, Nevada Partners' Workforce Development Division has provided services to **311** residents successfully exceeding the **275** residents projected to receive services this program year! The special populations we train include **20%** of TANF recipients, and formerly incarcerated individuals among others. Our return on investment has been over **\$5,816,928.00** going back into the Southern Nevada economy.

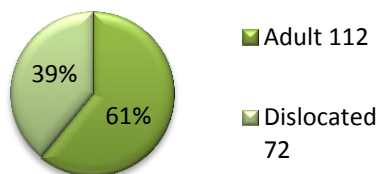


This effort includes providing training services to **184** job seekers and approximately **\$160,510** in supportive services like transportation assistance and tools. The result is a powerful return on investment for the community. To date, Nevada Partners has helped **177** residents gain employment, with an average hourly wage of **\$15.80**.

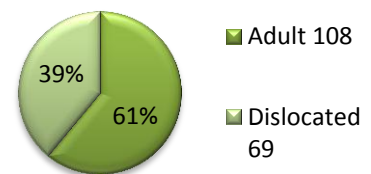
Enrollments

Outcomes



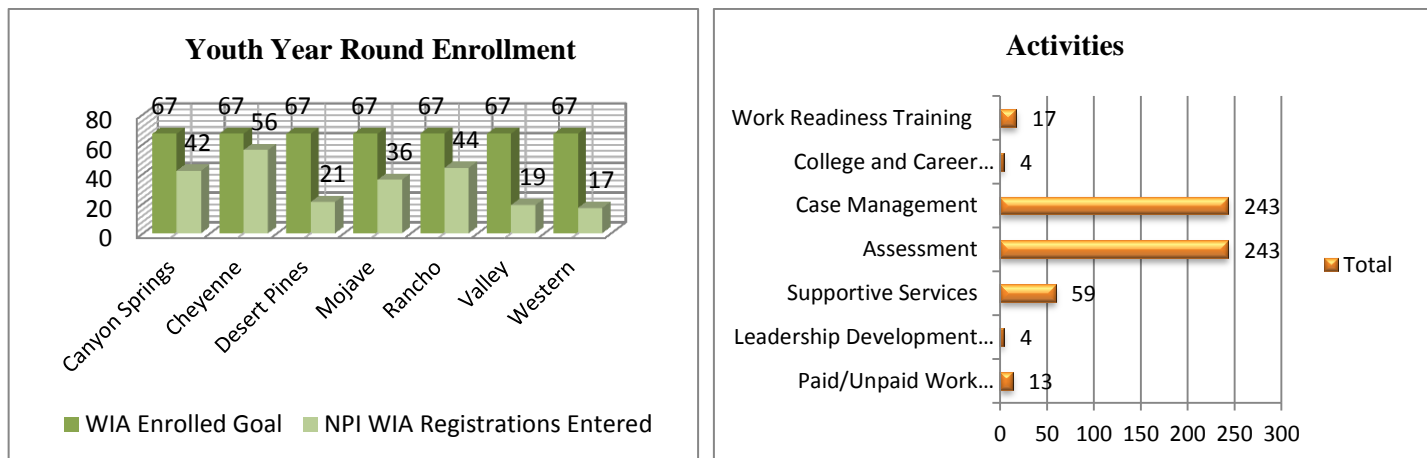
SUCCESS STORY

Mr. Jarman came to Nevada Partners seeking employment assistance, so he met with a counselor and staffing consultant to conduct an initial assessment and discussed additional job interests. Mr. Jarman indicated at his last job he was employed as a cashier/cook earning \$ 8.25 an hour. Mr. Jarman informed our staff he is currently in Bachelor's program for Psychology at the University of Las Vegas and is living with a family member until he is able to become self-sufficient. Client was in need of immediate employment to continue his education and establish sustainability. Nevada Partners' staffing consultant was able to provide an on-the-job training opportunity as a behavioral aide by paying 50% of the wages for a short period of time. Once Mr. Jarman completed the program, he was hired as a full time employee earning \$15.00 an hour. Mr. Jarman stated this position not only provided him with a good salary but also helped him gain additional skills to utilize once he receives his degree. Workforce Investment Act services are changing lives!

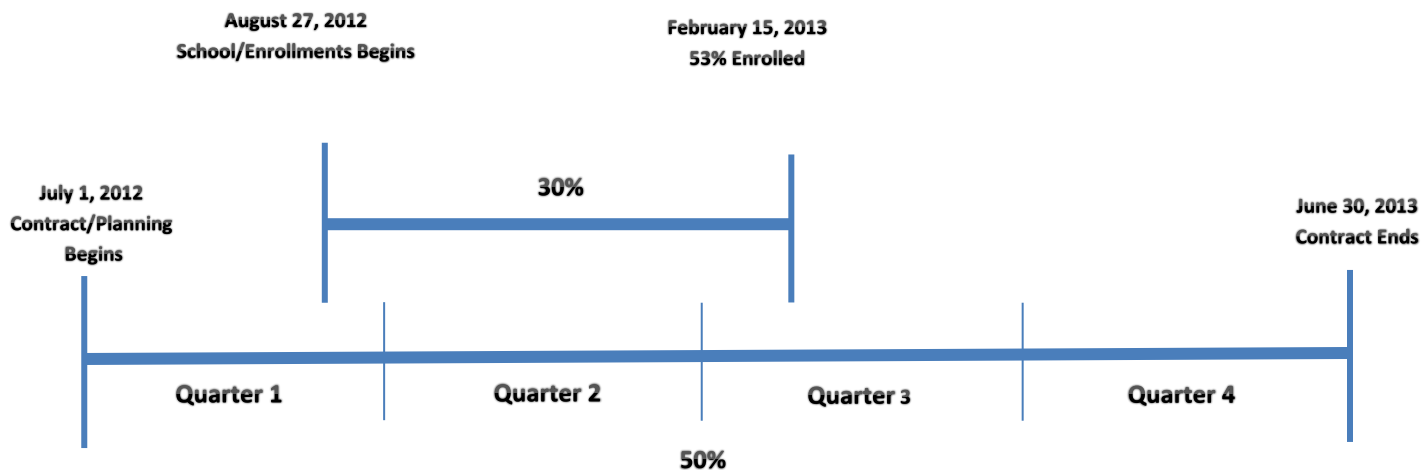
POSITIVE YOUTH IMPACT

Nevada Partners administers the Summer Year Round Grant and Graduate Advocate Initiative. Below is a profile of our youth enrollments and service provision.

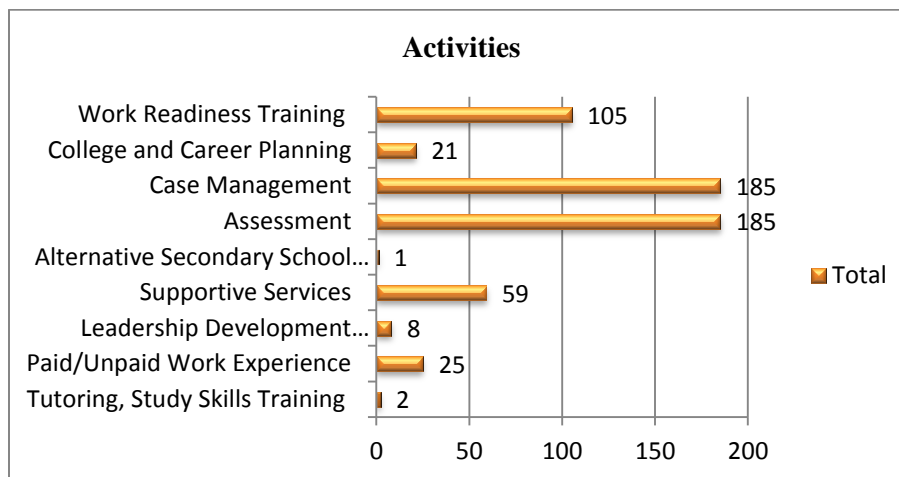
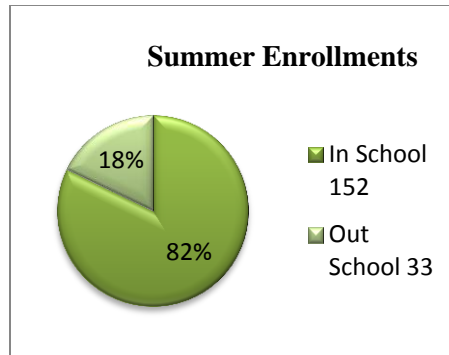
Year Round Grant

This spring, the student informed the counselor that the meeting over the break was an interview for acceptance into the program and was pleased to report he got accepted into UTI MMI for the fall of 2013.
