WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Nevada Partners is making strides! To date, Nevada Partners' Workforce Development Division has provided services to **402** residents, successfully exceeding the **275** residents projected to receive services this program year! The special populations we train include **17%** of TANF recipients, and formerly incarcerated individuals among others. Our return on investment has been over **\$7,588,963.20** in earned wages into the Southern Nevada economy.



This effort includes providing training services to **225** job seekers and approximately **\$263,758** in supportive services like transportation assistance and tools. The result is a powerful return on investment for the community. To date, Nevada Partners has helped **238** residents gain employment, with an average hourly wage of **\$15.33**.



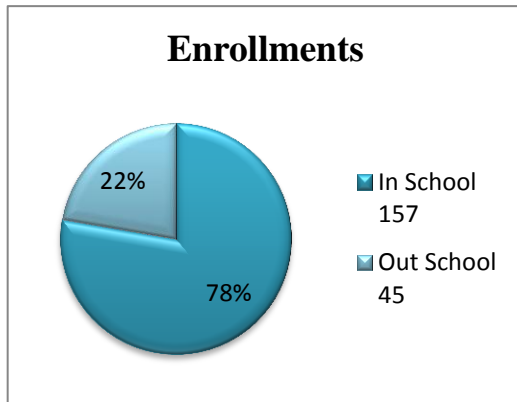
SUCCESS STORY

Ms. Rogers was previously employed as a psychosocial rehab worker and was interested in pursuing a career as a licensed Social Worker. Ms. Rogers came to Nevada Partners on July 19, 2012 seeking assistance with the fees associated with obtaining her social worker license. She took the Association of Social Worker Board examination on November 5, 2012 and was licensed on November 6, 2012. Upon obtaining her social worker license, Ms. Rogers was hired as a full-time social worker at the Boulder City Hospital, Inc. making \$21.00 an hour in the health care industry, with an employer that is providing a livable wage and medical benefits. Workforce Investment Act services are changing lives!

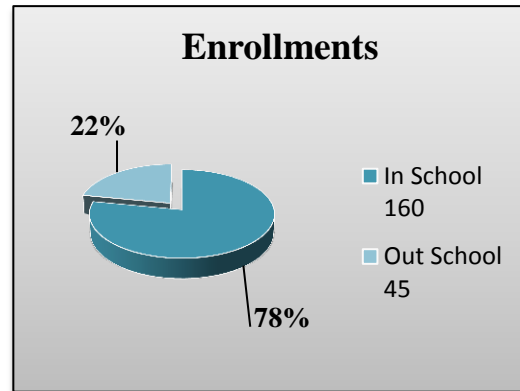
Positive Youth Impact

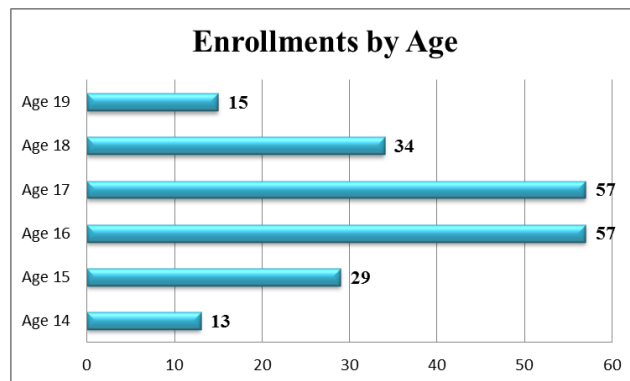
Summer Component/Year Round Grant Enrollments



Enrollments: 202

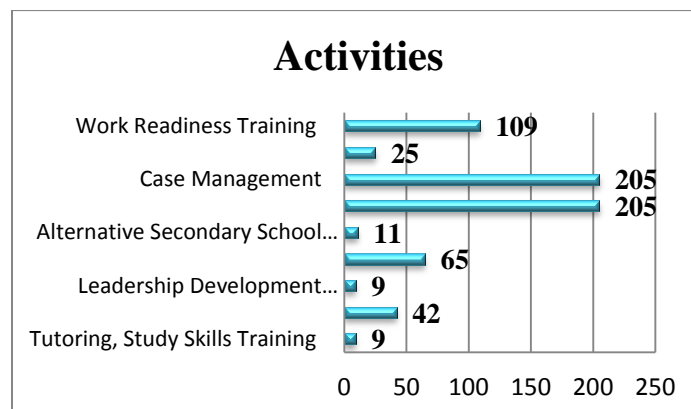

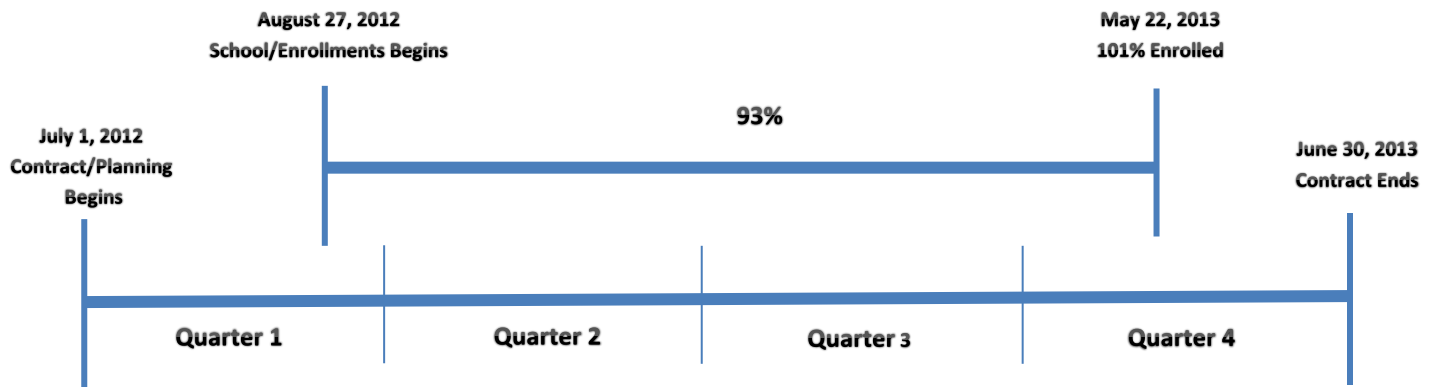
Summer Component/Year Round Grant Activities



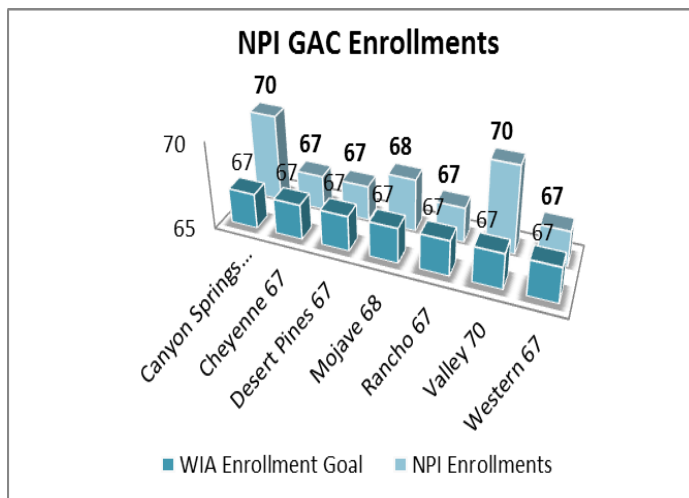
Graduate Advocate Initiative

Nevada Partners administers the Graduate Advocate Initiative. To date, Nevada Partners' Youth Division has provided services to **476** In School Youth, of the **460** youth participants projected to receive services this program year! Nevada Partners has completed **103%** of the projected enrollments. We are continuously working with the schools to promote the Graduate Advocate Initiative.

SUCCESS STORY

Mr. Gonzalez was withdrawn from high school due to lack of credits and failing mathematics of personal finance. After speaking to the youth participant, he was advised to apply for a reinstatement but his request was denied. Nevada Partners' case manager met with Mr. Gonzalez and he discussed how he was truly regretful of his mistakes and wanted another opportunity to show his dedication and commitment to school and graduating. The case manager advocated on Mr. Gonzalez's behalf and agreed to oversee his progress during four periods. Mr. Gonzalez was allowed reinstatement with a two-month probationary period to complete his credits. For a month and a half, Mr. Gonzalez came to the office every day for 4 hours and was able to complete the credits needed for graduation. Mr. Gonzalez is expected to graduate in June and is considering college as an option and enlisting as a reserve.
