



#### WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT


Nevada Partners is making strides! To date, Nevada Partners' Workforce Development Division has provided services to **423** residents successfully exceeding the **275** residents projected to receive services this program year! The special populations we train include **17%** of TANF recipients, and formerly incarcerated individuals among others. Our return on investment has been over **\$8,189,126.40** in earned wages into the Southern Nevada economy.



This effort includes providing training services to **244** job seekers and approximately **\$263,758** in supportive services like transportation assistance, work cards and tools. The result is a powerful return on investment for the community. To date, Nevada Partners has helped **258** residents gain employment, with an average hourly wage of **\$15.26**.








### **SUCCESS STORY**


Mr. Whitehead had been unemployed since 2011 and needed assistance with job search. He met with Ron Thomas, Staffing Consultant from Nevada Partners to assist him in finding employment and informed Mr. Thomas he was last employed as a human resource director. Mr. Thomas had a job opportunity with an employer who had a position for a safety and security director. Mr. Whitehead stated he had some knowledge in the field, but if the employer would be willing to train him he would be willing to apply for the position. The employer and the staffing consultant agreed to offer Mr. Whitehead an On The Job Training to provide him the skills needed to be hired as a safety and security director. Mr. Whitehead accepted the position and completed the training needed to become a full-time employee. Mr. Whitehead is currently working 40 hours a week earning \$ 21.63 per hour. NPI case manager provide client with work attire and will continue monitor him to provide job retention services for one year. Client was thankful for the assistance he received from Nevada Partners. Workforce Investment Act services are changing lives!


# **Summer Component/Year Round Grant Enrollments**










#### **Graduate Advocate Initiative**


