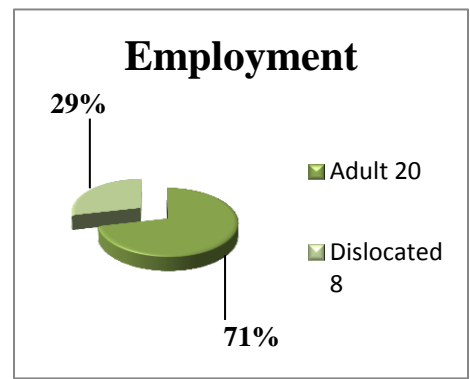
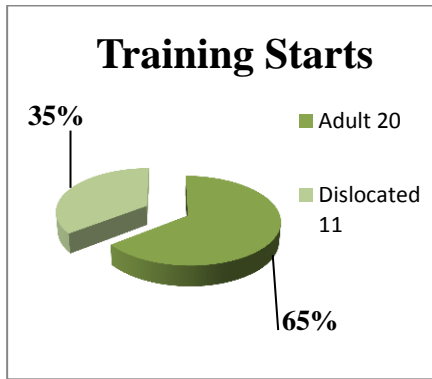
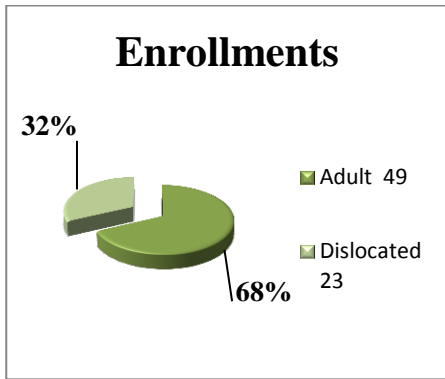


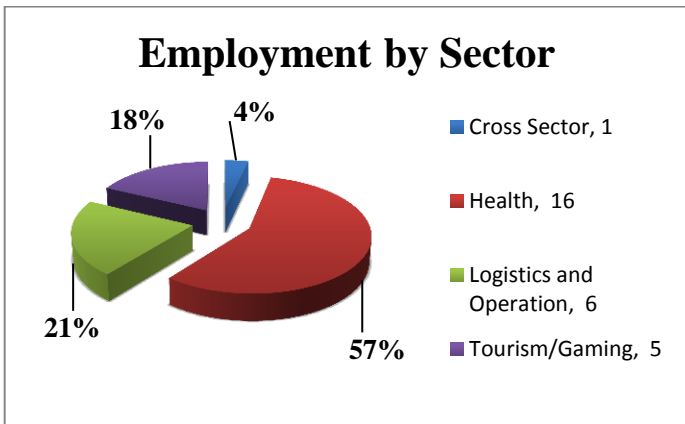


### WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Nevada Partners is making strides! To date, Nevada Partners' Workforce Development Division has provided services to **72** residents, which include **43** enrollments from the One Stop office, of the **500** residents projected to receive services this program year! The special populations we train include **19%** of TANF recipients, and formerly incarcerated individuals among others. Our return on investment has been over **\$1,173,536.00** in earned wages into the Southern Nevada economy.



This effort includes providing training services to **31** job seekers, **23** out of these from the One Stop office and approximately **\$9,018.06** in supportive services like transportation assistance, work cards and tools. The result is a powerful return on investment for the community. To date, Nevada Partners has helped **28** residents gain employment, with an average hourly wage of **\$20.15**.



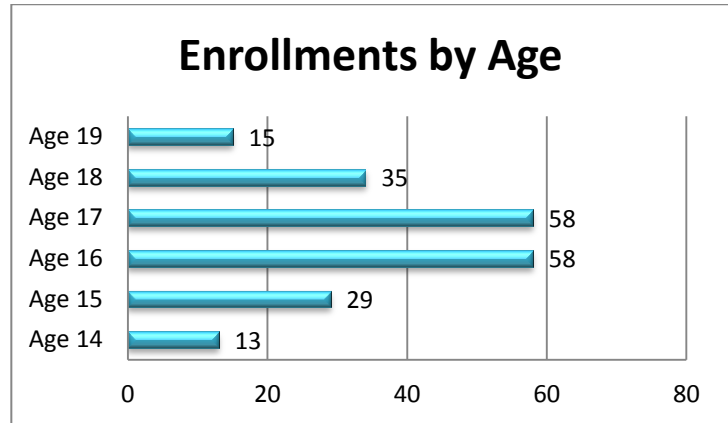
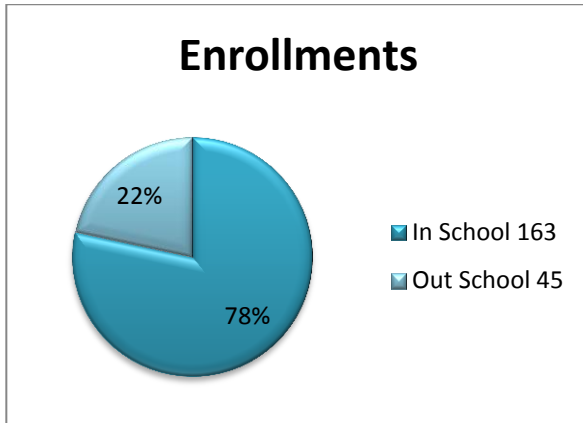
### SUCCESS STORY

Mr. Saiz was last employed in 2009 in the healthcare field with a wage of \$15.00 an hour. While still attending University of Nevada Las Vegas, Mr. Saiz was submitting applications for employment and on March 4, 2013 he received an acceptance letter for an Internship Program, contingent graduating from University of Nevada Las Vegas and receiving his licensing. Mr. Saiz graduated from University of Nevada Las Vegas on May 18, 2013 and came to Nevada Partners, Inc. seeking assistance for the fees associated with obtaining his license. Mr. Saiz started his internship on July 2, 2013 and is earning \$22.51 an hour with benefits. Workforce Investment Act services are changing lives!

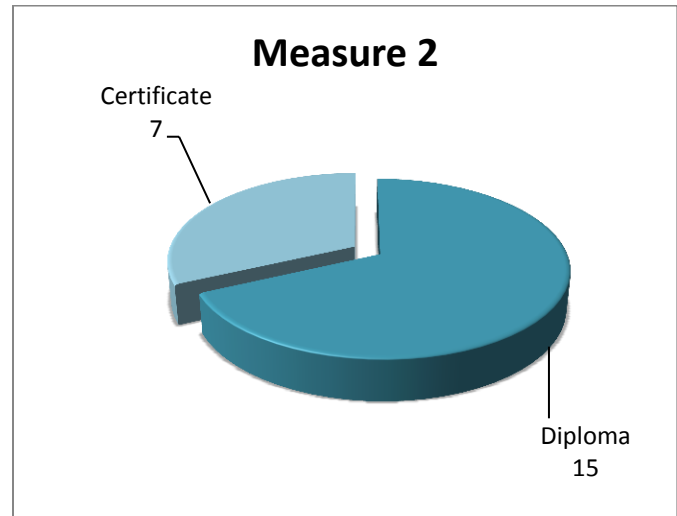
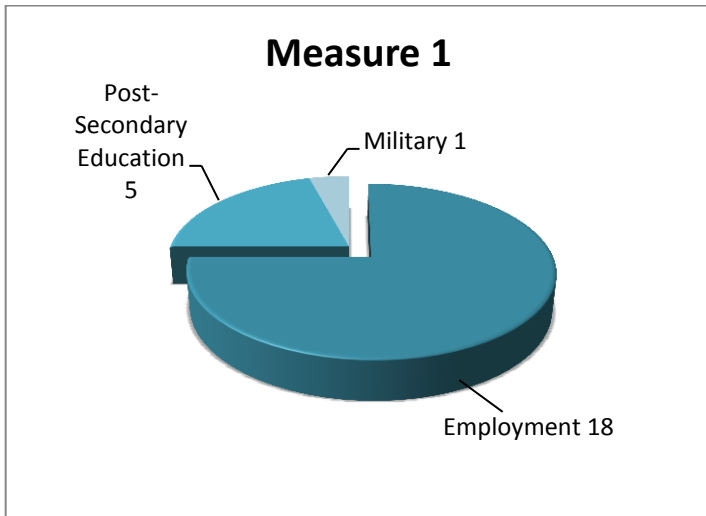

### Summer Component/Year Round Grant Performance Measures

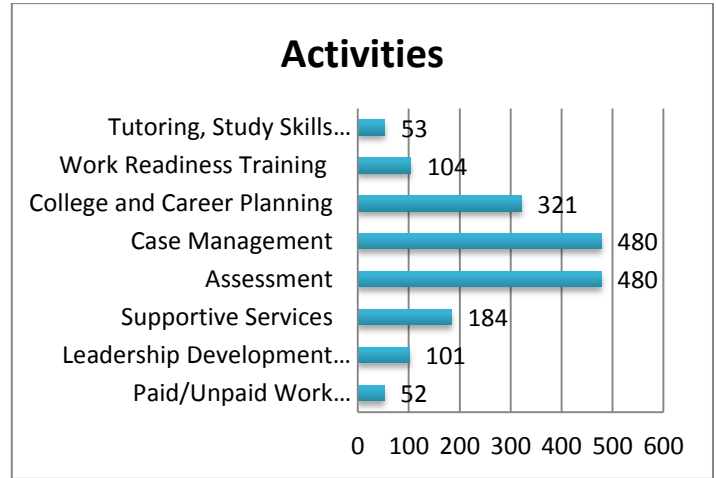
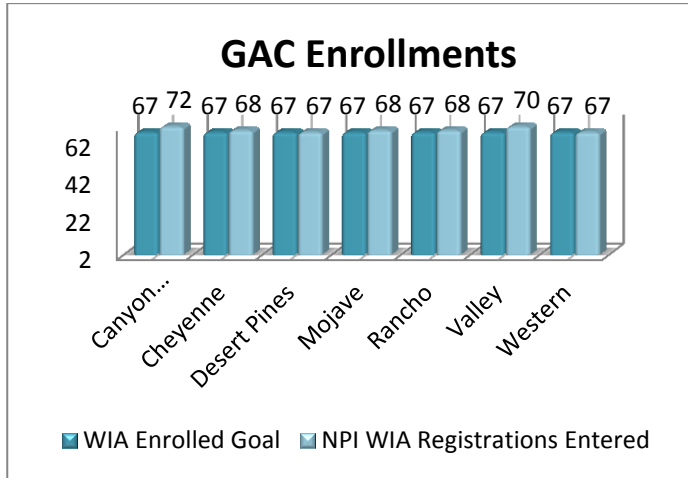


Nevada Partners has enrolled **88** youth participants for summer school including the Summer Component/Year Round Grant and Graduate Advocate Initiative.

## Graduate Advocate Initiative

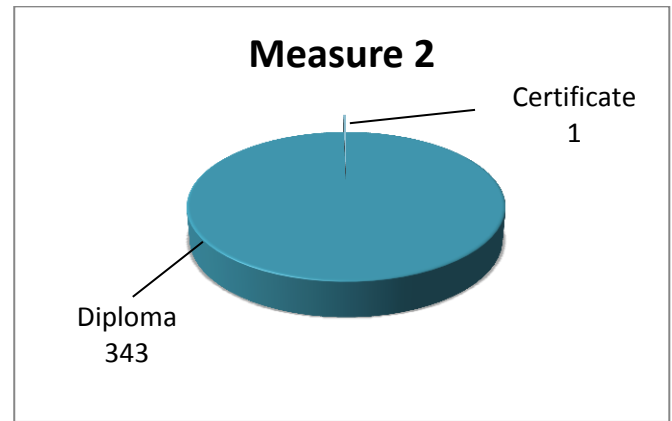
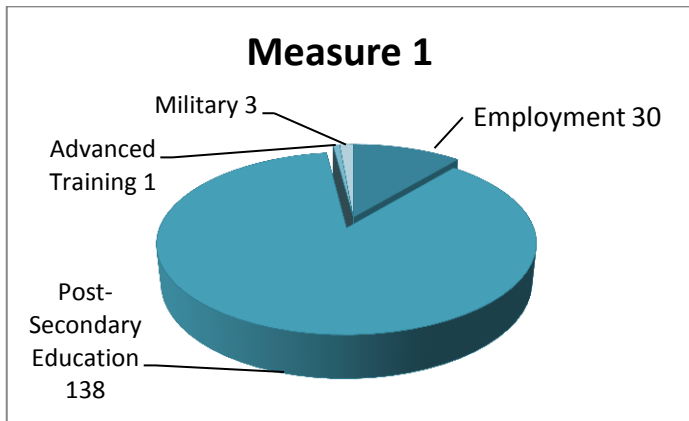
Nevada Partners administers the Graduate Advocate Initiative. To date, Nevada Partners' Youth Division has provided services to **480** In School Youth, of the **460** youth participants projected to receive services this program year! Over 70% of Graduate Advocate Initiative participants have successfully graduated; exceeding performance measures by 14%. With support from the initiative, **343** participants successfully graduated and **155** have been placed in employment or continued education (see measures below).

## SUCCESS STORY

Mr. Wright enrolled in Nevada Partners' youth program the summer of 2012 but dropped out of high school upon his release from Spring Mountain Youth Camp. His case manager made several attempts to locate and reengage Mr. Wright, but was not successful. After several attempts to reengage Mr. Wright, his case manager conducted a home visit, which resulted in his commitment to complete high school. Mr. Wright enrolled in summer school at Odyssey Charter School and successfully completed his summer school classes. As a result, he enrolled full-time in the fall to complete his high school diploma at Odyssey Charter School. Mr. Wright is currently completing his Work Experience at the Culinary Academy of Las Vegas where his supervisor commends him for being an excellent employee with a strong work ethic and his participation as a team player. Mr. Wright's case manager noted that she sees growth for Mr. Wright and he stated he has placed his life in a new direction. Workforce Investment Act youth services are changing lives!
