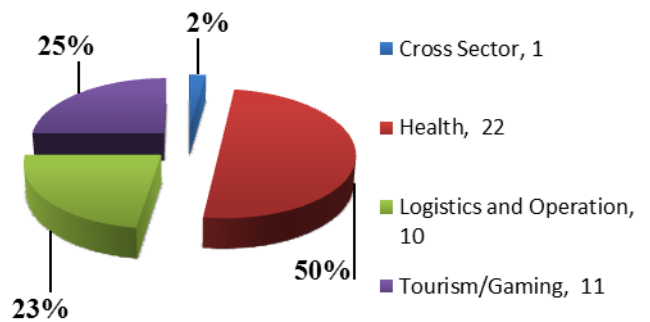
WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Nevada Partners is making strides! To date, Nevada Partners' Workforce Development Division has provided services to **131** residents, which include **74** enrollments from the One Stop office of the **500** residents projected to receive services this program year! The special populations we train include **22%** of TANF recipients, and formerly incarcerated individuals among others. Our return on investment has been over **\$1,877,075.20** in earned wages into the Southern Nevada economy.

Wage by Sector

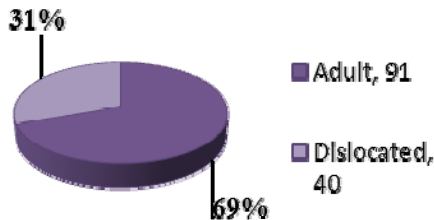


Employed by Sector

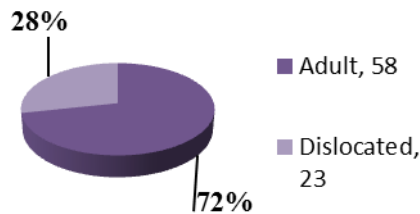


This effort includes providing training services to **81** job seekers, **55** out of these from the One Stop office and approximately **\$18,154** in supportive services like transportation assistance, work cards and tools. The result is a powerful start of return on investment for the community. To date, Nevada Partners has helped **44** residents gain employment, with an average hourly wage of **\$20.51**.

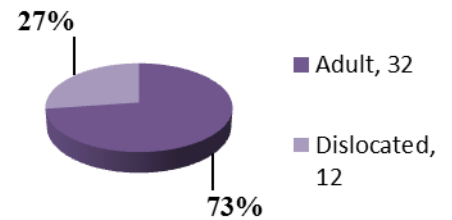
Enrollments

Ms. Perez was employed as a regional administrator for a local insurance company with a wage of \$13.00 per hour. Ms. Perez came to Nevada Partners, Inc. seeking supportive services for the fees associated with obtaining her license to become a Social Worker. Ms. Perez passed the Association of Social Worker Board examination and was licensed on May 5, 2013. Upon obtaining her Social Worker License, Ms. Perez was able to apply for employment as a Licensed Social Worker and was hired full-time in the Health Care industry as a Health Care Coordinator earning \$19.21 per hour and medical benefits. Workforce Investment Act services are changing lives!

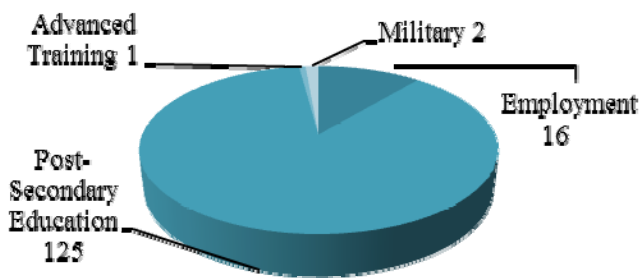


Graduate Advocate Initiative

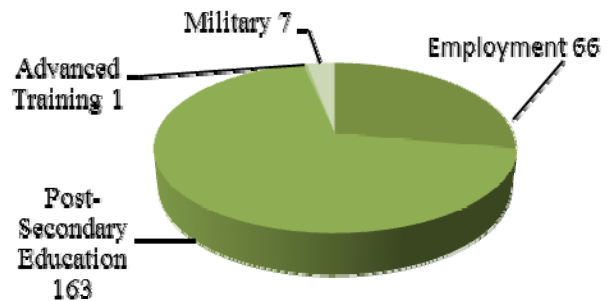

Graduate Advocate Initiative Performance Measures

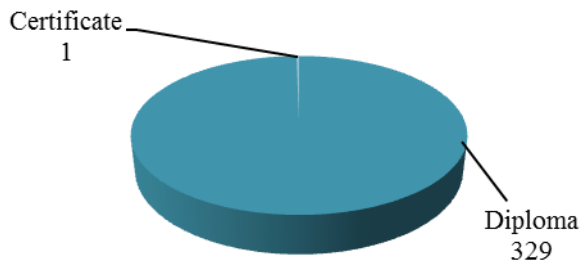
August - Measure 1



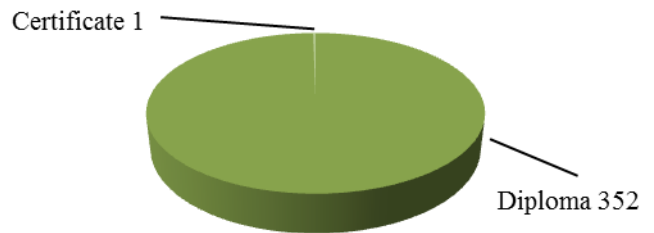
September - Measure 1

SUCCESS STORY

Mr. Mora was struggling in school when he first met his case manager Ms. Thomas. Mr. Mora was struggling with his core English course and needed to pass the math proficiency. On top of his academic struggles, Mr. Mora's family looked upon him to find a job and help support his family. After enrolling in Nevada Partners' youth program, Mr. Mora began participating in tutoring, field trips, and leadership workshops and obtained a work experience which led to permanent employment. Though Mr. Mora passed his math proficiency, he didn't initially pass his English class and did not receive his high diploma. Frustrated, Mr. Mora wanted to give up, but Ms. Thomas encouraged him to attend summer school to complete the credit needed and he passed his English course. Mr. Mora attained his high school diploma and also received a Professional Cook certificate from the Culinary Academy of Las Vegas. Mr. Mora will be attending College of Southern Nevada in the spring to continue his education. Workforce Investment Act youth services are changing lives!
