


Nevada Partners Workforce Investment Act Programs


WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Nevada Partners is making strides! To date, Nevada Partners' Workforce Development Division has provided services to **390** residents, which include **244** enrollments from the One Stop office of the **500** residents projected to receive services this program year! The special populations we train include **19%** of TANF recipients, and formerly incarcerated individuals among others. Our return on investment has been over **\$5,721,830.40** in earned wages into the Southern Nevada economy.






This effort includes providing training services to **248** job seekers, **162** out of these from the One Stop office and approximately **\$52,839** in supportive services like transportation assistance, work cards and tools. The result is a powerful start of return on investment for the community. To date, Nevada Partners has helped **176** residents gain employment, with an average hourly wage of **\$15.63**.







SUCCESS STORY

Mr. Bulen came to Nevada Partners in need of assistance with the fees associated for obtaining his licensing in the healthcare sector. Mr. Bulen had been unemployed since 2009 and did not have the resources to pay for the licensing fees and exam fee. Nevada Partners was able to assist Mr. Bulen by paying for the required fees, totaling \$2,395 in support services. Mr. Bulen recently graduated and has embarked into a full time career in the healthcare industry, earning a livable wage of \$23.56 an hour. Mr. Bulen was thankful he was able to receive the support needed and reported he is very happy to return to work. Workforce Investment Act Adult Services is changing lives!


Nevada Partners Workforce Investment Act Youth Programs

Mr. Chappell passed his writing proficiency on the last opportunity for the senior class of 2013. Because of the Graduate Advocate Initiative, Mr. Chappell was able to move forward and graduate from high school and is enrolled at Feather River College in Oregon on a full ride basketball scholarship. Mr. Chappell completed his first semester at college with a 3.0 grade point average and wants to pursue his MBA after he attains his Bachelor's degree in Business Administration
